

2023 Rainy River First Nations Trust APPLICATIONS



Community Purposes expenditures are those identified in Section 8.2(b) of the Trust Agreement and focus on ten primary areas for funding, subsections i thru x.

Applications for Community Purposes are received from both the Rainy River First Nations and individual Members. Applicants choose an 8.2(b) subsection for their application within the Trust Application Cover Sheet, however, applications may or may not be approved in the 8.2(b) subsection under which the application was received. Trustees review and make the final decision on the 8.2(b) subsection under which they will approve the application for funding. At times Trustees may deem an alternate subsection a better fit, than the section identified by the applicant.

The table below summarizes the applications received and approved for each of the ten 8.2(b) areas.

In 2023, the Trust received a total of 160 applications for funding.
