

Rainy River First Nations Trust 2025 APPLICATIONS



Community Purposes expenditures are those identified in Section 8.2(b) of the Trust Agreement and focus on ten primary categories for funding, subsections i thru x.

Applications for Community Purposes are received from both the Rainy River First Nations and individual Members. Applicants choose an 8.2(b) subsection for their application within the Trust Application Cover Sheet, however, applications may or may not be approved in the 8.2(b) subsection under which the application was received. Trustees review and make the final decision on the

8.2(b) subsection under which they will approve the application for funding. At times Trustees may deem an alternate subsection a better fit than the section identified by the applicant.
