The Rainy River First Nations Trust is excited to pilot two funding initiatives, for up to \$2,500, under the Supporting a Strong and Vibrant Community policy, which focus on **Community Spirit** and **Empowering Our Youth**.

These two funding initiatives align with the Trust Agreement use of Trust property in section 8.2(b) and complement the Trust Mission to support a strong and vibrant community by providing financial assistance for projects that enhance services, increase opportunities and empowers the lives of membership.

It is the goal of the Trust to support Members in getting involved in Trust activities as project applicants. We hope that Members will be inspired to develop project ideas and apply for funding, with the ultimate benefit being increased community spirit, additional support for our youth and new opportunities for Members to engage in.

WHAT IF MY PROJECT IDEA IS ABOVE \$2,500?

Any project ideas above \$2,500 can be submitted via the regular Trust application process and will be reviewed based on the quarterly Trust deadlines.

The funding initiatives will follow the same policies, submission deadlines and review processes currently in place within the Trust.

HOW TO APPLY

- Complete all sections of the Application Form.
- \mathcal{L} Attach a minimum of 2 quotes for any purchases/fees for service that will be made.
- 3. Attach an endorsement letter from Rainy River First Nations if using any community owned property.
- 4. Attach the participant list of Members who will be participating in the project.

General Guidelines

- Maximum funding for Community Spirit or Empowering Our Youth is \$2,500(CAD).
- Applications must include a detailed budget along with 2 quotes for any purchases of supplies/equipment or fees for service.
- Applications must include a minimum 5% project contribution which can be in the form of a cash contribution or cash equivalent.
- Volunteerism must be a primary component. Salaries and wages are not eligible costs.
- Applications can be submitted by individual Members (age of majority) or Member groups (not open to RRFN programs at this time).
- Applications must include a list of Members who will be participating in the project activities.
- Applications must include an endorsement letter from the Rainy River First Nations for use of any community property.
- Activities must aim to make a positive impact on the lives of Members of Rainy River First Nations and ensure Members are engaged and involved.

Community Spirit Funding

Projects must focus on one of the following six **key areas:**

- 1. **Community Spirit** (example: community meal, workshops, movie night, social gatherings, etc.)
- 2. **Community Health & Wellbeing** (example: workshops, cooking, walking group, etc.)
- 3. **Culture** (example: traditional activities, sewing groups, drumming, dancing, etc.)
- 4. **Recreation** (example: community walk, crafting groups, music, movie nights, game nights, etc.)
- 5. **Environment** (example: flower garden, tree planting, community clean up, park, trails, etc.)
- 6. **Technology** (example: computer workshops, internet safety, etc.)

For questions, clarification or assistance in completing the application form, contact the Trust Office.

Empowering Our Youth Funding

Projects must focus on one of the following seven **key areas:**

- 1. Readiness to Learn (example: homework program, literacy/numeracy workshops, etc.)
- 2. Youth Health & Wellbeing (example: healthy life choices, life skills, suicide prevention, etc.)
- 3. Culture, Recreation & the Arts (example: drumming, dancing, sport activities, art classes, etc.)
- 4. **Leadership Skills** (example: youth council, visiting speakers, leadership skills, etc.)
- 5. Planning for the Future (example: career fairs, post-secondary institutions, training, trades, etc.)
- 6. **Mentorship** (example: job placements, elder shadowing, learn abroad, partnerships, etc.)
- 7. Economic Development (example: young entrepreneurs, business plans, conferences, etc.)
